

Period of Cover

Schulfarm Insel Scharfenberg is a

boarding school with a simply fantastic location: on beautiful Island Scharfenberg in Lake Tegel. The Island is within the city limits of Berlin, northwest of the city center. As this school is a public school, it is significantly less pricey than the other boarding schools around Berlin, which are private schools.

The School

... was founded in 1929, on the grounds of a beautiful farm with horse stables and botanic garden. All school facilities are on the island - classrooms, photo laboratory, cafeteria, sailing station, boarding houses for boys and girls. The whole island belongs to the school, it is not only a very safe, but also a very beautiful environment - with lots of opportunities for swimming, sailing and canoeing. It takes about 50 minutes to get to the city center of Berlin: by ferry or rowing boat first, then bus or metro.









Learning with head, heart and hand... the students live, learn and work according to this motto at the school farm Insel Scharfenberg, is a state grammar school with an affiliated boarding school. The school farm is a "school of special pedagogical character" and is run as a tied all-day school. This includes:

- a school's own kitchen with catering
- a special teaching concept: Trimester instead of half-years (7th - 9th grade)
- a new rhythmisation of everyday school life in 60-minute and 75-minute blocks
- learning in another form ("LiaF"): project weeks spanning several subjects and years
- wind and water sports
- binding project teaching: practical learning, e.g. horticulture, agriculture, horse riding, sailing, rowing, scientific experimentation, beekeeping
- elective (9th/10th grade): e.g. Spanish, Latin, Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Music, Water Sports, Arts, Performing Arts, Political Science, Languages: English, French, Spanish









The boarding school consists of single houses with 2- and 4-bed rooms and accommodates approx. 90 students. Educational support is provided by the dedicated team of educators and a social worker from the independent organisation tifbg.

School and boarding school form a pedagogical unit. Both areas work towards common educational goals and are characterized by a spirit of solidarity. School and boarding school committees work closely together and solve emerging conflicts in solidarity. The pupils - also in the tradition of the founding years of the school farm - are involved to a high degree in the design and decision-making processes of the community togetherness.


Accommodation:

The majority of the German students lives at home, most boarders are international students. The boarding house is not right next to the school - it is on the campus of the Teikyo foundation on Lake Zeuthen.


